Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

Saint Benedict Catholic School Year 6 Open Evening

I do hope that Year 6 has started well for your child. You will be aware the closing date for applications for secondary school places for next year must be submitted to your local authority by the 31st October 2021. The purpose of this letter is to set out the information you need about applying to Saint Benedict Catholic School.

When is Open Evening?

On Monday 27th September, we will publish our <u>Virtual Open Evening Page</u> so that you have the
opportunity to find out all about the school before our online live event. This page will remain
available right up until the deadline for applications so that you and your children can visit it as
many times as you wish.

This will include a home page for whole school information and separate pages for each of our curriculum areas. You can expect to find:

- o Each Subject Director of Learning introducing themselves, their subject areas and telling you what you need to know about studying their subject at Saint Benedict Catholic School
- The Head Boy and Head Girl telling you about themselves and their experiences at Saint Benedict School
- o Year 7 students talking about their first few weeks at Saint Benedict School
- o A message from Mrs Best your future Head of Year on the pastoral life of the school.
- On Thursday 30th September at 6pm, we will run a live presentation on Microsoft Teams for all parents and carers. This will include a presentation from myself and an opportunity to meet key staff at Saint Benedict School. The Head Boy and Head Girl will also join us for this evening. You can access the event by following this <u>link</u> on the 30th September from 5.45pm. During the presentation, there will be a live Q&A stream, which you can use to ask us any questions about the school.

Why is Open Evening online this year?

In the absence of any national guidance, we must navigate our own way through how we will run parents' events during this term whilst we remain in a pandemic. The Year 6 Open Evening is a huge event that brings together children and families from primary schools across Derby City and Derbyshire. In order to ensure we continue to keep everyone safe, we have elected to run the event virtually.
