Dear Parents,

It has been confirmed today that we are experiencing a COVID outbreak in Y2.

We are taking action and following the external guidance that we have received are **closing both Year 2 classes** for the rest of this week.

All children are advised to go for a PCR test as they are close contacts. There is capacity in the city at the moment for you to book a test. When booking, there are several sections to go through. One section asks – 'Why are you asking for a test?' with several options to tick.

Please choose — 'I've been told to get a test by my local council, health protection team or healthcare professional'. This is because you are following the advice from Public Health.

As a school, we have a duty to report any positive cases to the local authority. If your child tests positive on a PCR test, please let us know by emailing helpline@jph.srscmat.co.uk. Siblings can continue to come in to school as normal unless they show any signs of being unwell. If a child in Year 2 tests positive siblings can come into school but must do a lateral flow test each morning for 7 days.

Children will be able to return to school on Monday 7th February.

Learning resources will be available for the children on Google Classroom as well as those sent home with them today.
