Programme Pathways (Life to the Full Primary Schools)

- No two schools will roll out 'Life to the Full' in the same way. Every school should make an independent decision about when and how the lessons should be taught. At Ten Ten Resources, we have provided a comprehensive and fully-resourced Scheme of Work in statutory Relationship Education within a Catholic context. However, it would do the programme, you and your pupils a disservice to simply take it 'off the shelf'. One of the ways we help schools understand how to structure 'Life to the Full' sessions within their annual timetable, is to offer several 'pathways' through the programme.
- There are three pathways we have created for you. Expand the side menu (using the sidebar icon at the top left of the page) and click on Planning. Programme Pathways can be found on the Programme Coordinators page. Click the Programme Pathways accordion. (Your Programme Coordinator can tell you which pathway your school is using.)
- Select the Programme Pathway that your school will be following, either 1, 2 or 3. Click
 to see an overview of the pathway you are taking and expand the menu to see an
 overview of each learning stage. Click on any of the session titles to access the
 resources.
- Whichever pathway your school chooses to follow, you will find helpful notes on Differentiation for Pupils by clicking on Planning in the sidebar menu, followed by Lesson Planning, and then the Differentiation for your Pupils accordion. Here you'll find information on Age and Stage Differentiation, Extended Activities (which will be particularly useful to schools who choose pathway 3 and intend to run the whole programme every year) and finally information about SEND/ALN differentiation.
