Wave I	Quality First Teaching is provided for all our pupils daily and will address most pupils' needs.				
Wave 2	This provision is targeted and is additional to what is provided to all children. This is normally in the form of small group interventions to accelerate the progress of learners. These are not primarily for children with SEND and they do not have to be on the SEND register to access these. Children will be identified through data analysis and/or teacher request. Parents will be notified by letter is their child has been identified for intervention.				
Funding: Teaching Assistant costs, external agency costs, interventions and equipment and resources all contribute to Wave I and 2.					
Wave 3	This is targeted support and, in some cases, personalised teaching for children with SEND who are identified as requiring additional support. This will be put into place for children who are not making enough progress through wave I or 2 provision or for children who require specific individual SEND provision. Some children in wave 3 may require an EHCP and additional funding.				
	When we apply for additional Top-Up funding, the notional SEND is taken into account before any further High Needs Top Up funding is allocated.
